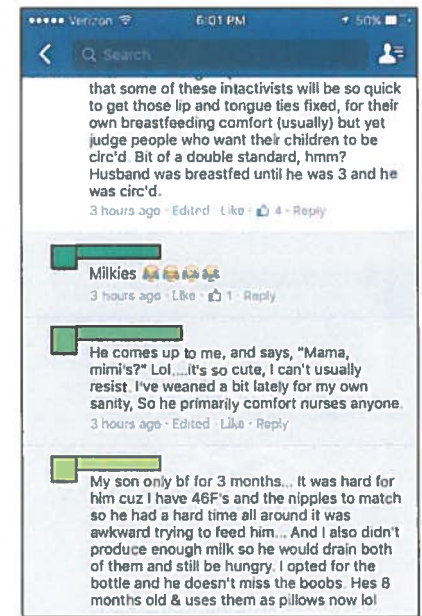
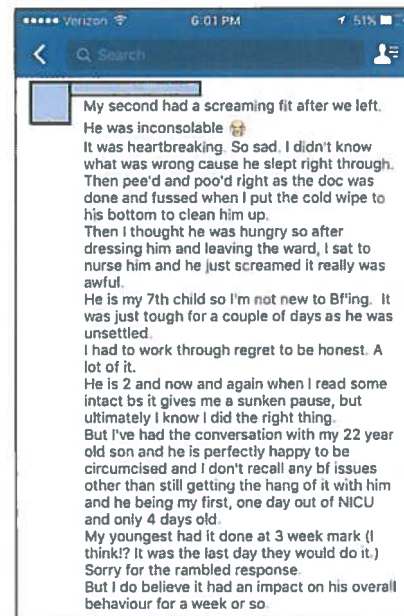
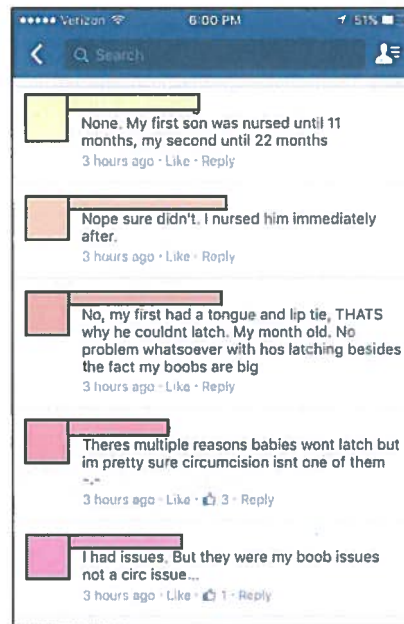
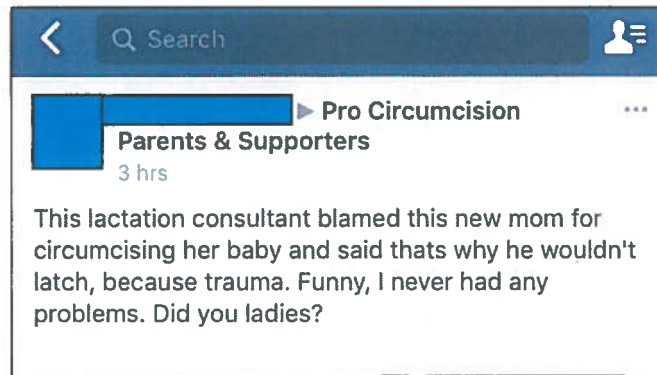


DOES CIRCUMCISION AFFECT BREASTFEEDING?

I had trouble more before the circumcision than after. He was born a premie and was a week and a half old when they circumcised him. When he got to come home he latched very well and never even showed any symptoms of pain or "trauma" from being circumcised.

Not at all I breast fed my son with no problem after having him circumcised never had a latching issue

My oldest went almost 12 hrs without nursing the day after he was born (or rather about 12 hrs after birth). Eventually he latched again and went back to every 2 hrs like the first 12 hrs of his life. As the nurses in hospital told me this is normal for some babies as birth is hard work for them too. Had he been circ'd right after birth (before the 12 hr no feeding) I wonder if I would have experienced comments on how it was the circ at fault.
